

Historic Bedford Dine Around

October 14, 2010 - Thursday

Stimulate your appetite and expand your mind while visiting **Bedford County, PA...**

Your local guide will meet you upon arrival in Bedford for a progressive "eating" tour that will include visits to several different restaurants while learning and visiting fun and historic sites in the Bedford area.



As you begin your journey toward downtown **Bedford** you will stop for photos at the **Claycomb Covered Bridge**, which spans the Raystown branch of the Juniata River. A stop for coffee and pastry at **Founders Crossing** follows. Next you will learn about the **Bedford Springs Hotel** (summer White House of President James Buchanan); the oldest operational *Court House* in the Commonwealth; a *Civil War Monument*; *Pre-American Revolutionary Cemetery* and journey west on the *Old Forbes Trail*.



A stop at the **Jean Bonnet Tavern** for hot soup, fresh salad and rolls is followed by a short ride to **Schellsburg Long Church** and the cemetery with epitaphs.

The second covered bridge of the tour features glistening white-boarded sides and a native stone abutment – The **Snook Covered Bridge**, next we make a short stop at **Reynoldsdale Fish Culture Station**. Main Course will be served at **Slick's Ivy Stone Restaurant** where you will also be able to enjoy the antiques and collectibles displayed throughout the facility.

Another covered bridge – **The Bowser Bridge** will take us to **Fishers Country Store** for some time to shop in this Mennonite operated facility, which features a large array of bulk foods and candies.



We save the best for last!!!!!! *Dessert!!* Served at **Clara's Place** near Bedford. After saying goodbye to your guide, lean back and relax on a full stomach as you reminisce about the life and times of early colonialists.
