

HOW TO SEND AND RECEIVE A WIRE TRANSFER

When you need to move dollars quickly and securely, our wire services are the answer. Here is a quick guide to wire transfers.

There are three ways to send or receive a wire transfer.

- 1.** Visit your local branch
- 2.** By telephone. You will need to fill out and sign a Funds Transfer Agreement first
- 3.** Through BOSS, our Business Online Solution.

Sending a wire transfer

You will need the following:

- A valid driver's license or other governmental photo identification
- Your account information
- Beneficiary bank name and address
- Beneficiary bank SWIFT code (international wires only)
- IBAN or other necessary codes (where required)
- Beneficiary bank routing number (domestic wires only)
- Beneficiary account number
- Beneficiary name and full address (as listed on beneficiary account)
- References for the beneficiary (if applicable)
- Additional information as required by beneficiary bank (if applicable)

Receiving a wire transfer

Domestic Wire Transfers:

You must have a Fulton Bank deposit account in order to receive a domestic wire transfer.

You will need the following information:

- Bank Name: Fulton Bank, N.A.
- Bank Address: One Penn Square, Lancaster, PA 17602
- Fulton Bank Routing Number: 031301422
- Your name
- Your address
- Account number

International Wire Transfers:

You must have a Fulton Bank in order to receive an international wire transfer.

You will need the following information:

- Bank Name: Fulton Bank, N.A.
- Bank Address: One Penn Square, Lancaster, PA 17602 USA
- Fulton SWIFT Code: FLBKUS33
- Fulton Bank Routing Number: 031301422
- Your name
- Your address
- Account Number
- IBAN (if required): US [Routing number] [Account Number]
- Under Special Instructions include any Special Payment Instructions
